PET INSTRUCTIONS

- The total appointment time is approximately 2 hours.
- Once you arrive you will be given a sugar based isotope injection This will take approximately 45 minutes to circulate through your system.
- You will then be placed in the scanner. The scanner is very similar to the CT scan.
- **Non-Diabetic Patients:**
 - No food for six (6) hours prior to study
 - May drink water
 - No other type of liquid is allowed
 - May take regularly scheduled medications if they can be tolerated on an empty stomach
 - Should be able to lay flat on his/her back for 25 minutes unless Melanoma appointment which would be 60 minutes
- **Diabetic: Non-Insulin Dependent Patients:** (schedule early or late afternoon)
 - Take oral medications
 - Have light breakfast
 - May drink water
 - No other type of liquid is allowed
 - Should be able to lay flat on his/her back for 25 minutes Melanoma appointment which would be 60 minutes
 - Please bring your glucometer with you to appointment
- **Insulin Dependent Patients:** (if patient is on subcutaneous medication)
 - Take insulin and monitor glucose level (4) hours prior to appointment
 - Eat a regular meal four (4) hours prior to appointment
 - May drink water
 - No other type of liquid is allowed
 - Should be able to lay flat on his/her back for 25 minutes unless Melanoma appointment which would be 60 minutes
 - Please bring your glucometer with you to appointment
- ****ALL PATIENTS:**
 - NO caffeine, gum, cough drops or mints
 - NO strenuous exercising 24 hours prior to the scan
 - Wear warm, loose-fitting clothing (i.e. sweats, flannel shirt, etc.) because the room is kept between 60-65 degrees
 - Please bring your insurance cards with you and a list of any medications that you're currently taking
 - Please bring any prior CT films that you have had in the past
 - After your scan there is no waiting period, you can go about the rest of your day with no restrictions
